



Antibiotic Prophylaxis for Surgical Procedures

Procedure	Cause	Drug of choice	Dose	Alternative	Dose
Cardiac surgery	<i>S.aureus</i> , <i>Staphylococci</i>	Cefazolin	2g IV if <120 KG, 3gm IV if > 120 KG.	Clindamycin	900 mg IV every 6 hours
Breast surgery	<i>S. aureus</i> , other <i>staphylococci</i> , and <i>streptococci</i> .	Cefazolin	2g IV if <120 KG, 3gm IV if > 120 KG.	Vancomycin Clindamycin	15 mg/kg IV max 2gm. 900 mg IV every 6 hours
Percutaneous surgery	<i>S.aureus</i> and <i>Staphylococci</i>	Cefazolin	2g IV if <120 KG, 3gm IV if > 120 KG.	Vancomycin Clindamycin	15 mg/kg IV max 2gm. 900 mg IV every 6 hours
Vascular surgery	<i>S.aureus</i> & <i>Staphylococci</i> and enteric gram -ve bacilli.	Cefazolin	2g IV if <120 KG, 3gm IV if > 120 KG.	Vancomycin Clindamycin	15 mg/kg IV max 2gm. 900 mg IV every 6 hours
Head and neck surgery	<i>S.aureus</i> & <i>Staphylococci</i> and <i>streptococci</i>	Cefazolin	2g IV if <120 KG, 3gm IV if > 120 KG.	Vancomycin Clindamycin	15 mg/kg IV max 2gm. 900 mg IV every 6 hours
Thoracic surgery	<i>S.aureus</i> & <i>Staphylococci</i> , <i>streptococci</i> and enteric gram -ve bacilli.	Cefazolin	2g IV if <120 KG, 3gm IV if > 120 KG.	Vancomycin Clindamycin	15 mg/kg IV max 2gm. 900 mg IV every 6 hours
Gynecologic and obstetric surgery		Cefazolin	2g IV if <120 KG, 3gm IV if > 120 KG.	Ampicillin-sulbactam Clindamycin Vancomycin Ampicillin-sulbactam	3gm IV every 2 hours 900 mg IV every 6 hours 15 mg/kg IV max 2gm. 3gm IV every 2 hours
In case of abortion : drug of choice is Doxycycline 100 mg orally one hour before procedure and 200 mg after procedure					
Genitourinary surgery	enteric gram -ve bacilli and enterococci	Ciprofloxacin Sulfamethoxazole, trimethoprim	500mg oral or 400 mg IV 160/800 Qn oral dose		
In case of open or laparoscopic surgery Cefazolin is considered drug of choice.					
GIT surgery	Enteric gram -ve bacilli, gram -ve cocci and enterococci.	Cefazolin	2g IV if <120 KG, 3gm IV if > 120 KG every 4 hours		
In case of small intestine surgery, appendectomy and colorectal surgery Metronidazole should be added by a dose of 500mg IV
