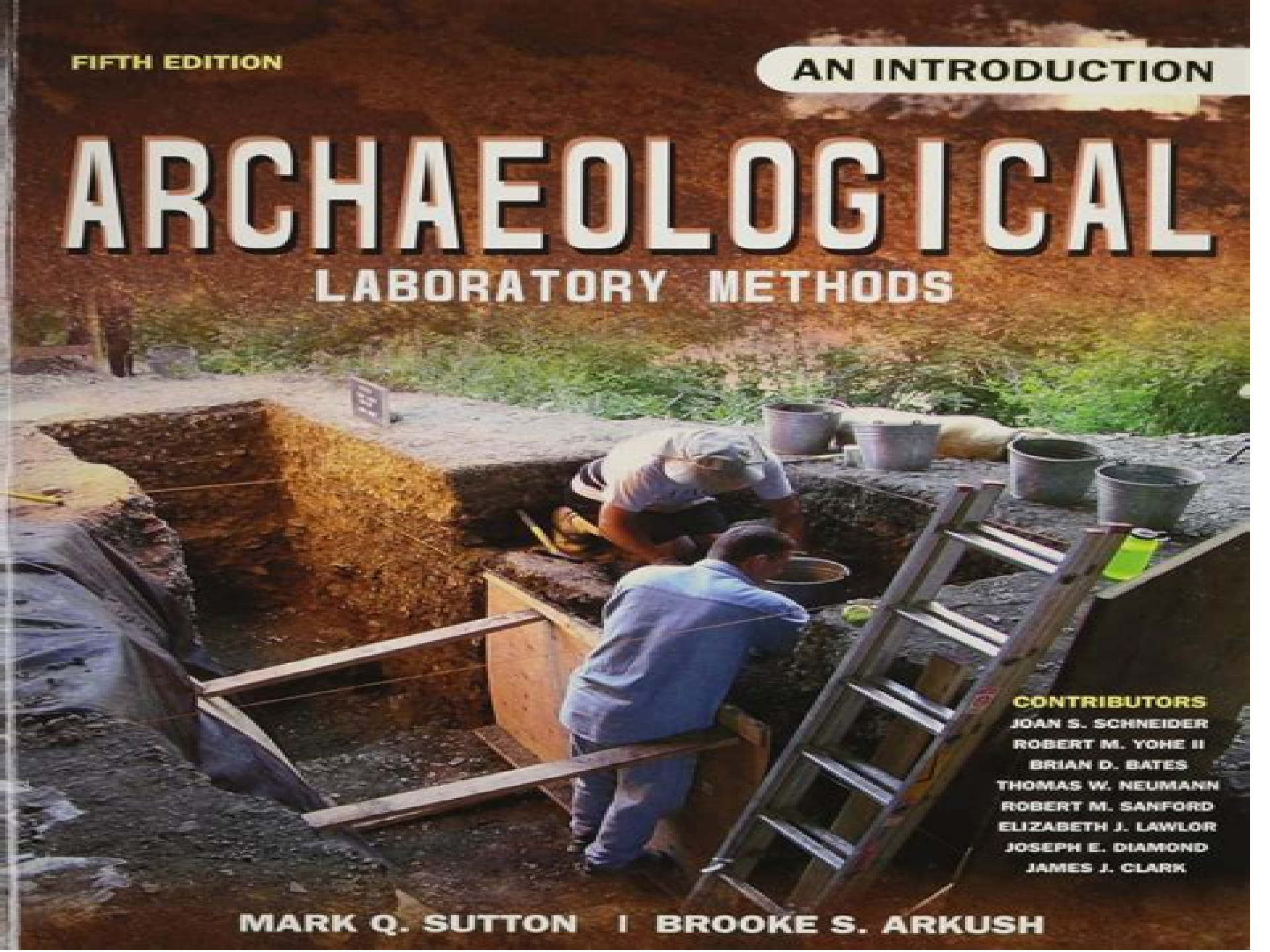

Scott, 1987 In August 1983 a grassfire raged up Deep Ravine and across the dry grass covered battlefield where in 1876 men of the Seventh U S Cavalry under George Armstrong Custer had fought and died at the hands of a Sioux and Cheyenne force led by Sitting Bull The removal of the normally dense ground cover revealed enough evidence to suggest that an
