The State, Democracy and Anti-Terror Laws in India Ujjwal Kumar Singh, 2007-01-12 Laws like the Prevention of Terrorism Act POTA are enacted to address what the state describes as extraordinary situations and put in place exceptions to the ordinary legal and judicial procedures By examining public debates surrounding extraordinary laws like POTA and the Terrorist and Disruptive Activities Prevention Act TADA and also specific cases trials and judgements under the Acts the author argues that extraordinary laws have ramifications for people's lives political institutions the rule of law and democratic functioning shows how such laws assume normalcy and acquire a place of permanence in state practices and examines the ways in which such extraordinary laws manifest dominant configurations of political power and ideology While exploring the unfolding of POTA in specific contexts the book shows how the law was enmeshed in the politics of Hindutva electoral and coalition politics centre state relations the politics of repression and reconciliation against nationality struggles and issues of poverty and development

Presidential Power, Rhetoric, and the Terror Wars Alexander Hiland, 2019-10-21 Presidential Power Rhetoric and the Terror Wars The Sovereign Presidency argues that the War on Terror provided an opportunity to fundamentally change the presidency Alexander Hiland analyzes the documents used to exercise presidential powers including executive orders signing statements and presidential policy directives Treating these documents as genres of speech act that are ideologically motivated Hiland provides a rhetorical criticism that illuminates the values and political convictions at play in these documents This book reveals how both President George W Bush and President Barack Obama wielded the personal power of the office to dramatically expand the power of the executive branch During the War on Terror the presidency shifted from an imperial form that avoided checks and balances to a sovereign presidency where the executive branch had the ability to decide whether those checks and balances existed As a result Hiland argues that this shift to the sovereign presidency enabled the violation of human rights myriad policy mistakes and the degradation of democracy within the United States

Islamic Terror and the Balkans Shaul Shay, 2017-07-12 The disintegration of Yugoslavia in the early 1990s ended the Yugoslavian Federation which for nearly fifty years had succeeded in preserving a delicate coexistence among the ethnic religious and national components contained within it Following this the Balkans became a violent arena of confrontation due to these warring factions Islamic Terror and the Balkans describes and analyzes the growth of radical Islam in the Balkans from its inception during the years of World War II to the present Shay's account shows how the Bosnian War between the Muslims and the Serbs provided the historical opportunity for radical Islam to penetrate the Balkans at a time when the Muslim world headed by Iran and the various Islamic terror organizations including Al Qaida came to the aid of the Muslims in Bosnia In the framework of the mobilization of these entities in aiding the Muslim side in the conflict the operational and organizational infrastructure of Iranian intelligence and the Revolutionary Guards was established as well as those operated by other Islamic terror organizations When war in Bosnia ended terrorist

infrastructures remained in the Balkans and served as a basis for these entities intervention in the confrontation that developed in the Balkans in the late 1990s specifically in Kosovo and Macedonia Today the Balkans serve as a forefront on European soil for Islamic terror organizations which exploits this area to promote their activities in Western Europe Russia and other focal points worldwide Shay s analysis of terror activity in the aftermath of the September 11 attacks and exposure of terror cells throughout the world and particularly in Europe attest to the increasing involvement of the Balkan alumni and of the terrorist infrastructure from this area in creating global terror activity

Terrorism, the Worker and the City Dr Luke Howie, 2012-08-28 Soon after watching the twin towers falling in New York some of those with business responsibilities were already asking themselves whether people would be willing to work in tall buildings ever again Is work too risky How can people be expected to attend work in what might now be seen as precarious and vulnerable workplaces and cities Although thankfully large scale terrorist attacks are infrequent the world s cities and the businesses to which they are home have been put on notice that it can come to any place at any time In *Terrorism the Worker and the City* Luke Howie considers what steps managers and employees can and should take to protect their businesses from such an amorphous and indefinable threat Deftly combining theoretical insight with empirical research he reveals how despite an appearance of business as usual fear anxiety and suspicion permeate workplaces even in cities that may not be at the top of any terrorist group s target list Using the Australian city of Melbourne a cosmopolitan city and major business centre with nearly four million people as a metaphor for other such cities around the world Dr Howie s research has uncovered that even where they don t perceive a high level threat business managers who might face having to account for themselves to some post event Inquiry have taken action in consequence of the situation Often that action amounts to the introduction of what can be described as Simulated Security This cannot ever provide certain protection from terrorist attack but it may be the best we can reasonably do There is also evidence that it can be effective in terms of providing the reassurance to counter the terrorist objective of disrupting normal life through fear With its rigorous research compared with other more speculative works on this subject *Terrorism the Worker and the City* will appeal to city and business leaders and managers and security professionals as well as those in governmental and academic research communities for all of whom terrorism is now an ever present concern

The Age of Lone Wolf Terrorism Mark S. Hamm, Ramón Spaaij, 2017-05-09 The lethality of lone wolf terrorism has reached an all time high in the United States Isolated individuals using firearms with high capacity magazines are committing brutally efficient killings with the aim of terrorizing others yet there is little consensus on what connects these crimes and the motivations behind them In *The Age of Lone Wolf Terrorism* terrorism experts Mark S Hamm and Ram n Spaaij combine criminological theory with empirical and ethnographic research to map the pathways of lone wolf radicalization helping with the identification of suspected behaviors and recognizing patterns of indoctrination Reviewing comprehensive data on these actors including more than two hundred terrorist incidents Hamm and Spaaij find that a combination of personal and political

grievances lead lone wolves to befriend online sympathizers whether jihadists white supremacists or other antigovernment extremists and then announce their intent to commit terror when triggered Hamm and Spaaij carefully distinguish between lone wolves and individuals radicalized within a group dynamic This important difference is what makes this book such a significant manual for professionals seeking richer insight into the transformation of alienated individuals into armed warriors Hamm and Spaaij conclude with an analysis of recent FBI sting operations designed to prevent lone wolf terrorism in the United States describing who gets targeted strategies for luring suspects and the ethics of arresting and prosecuting citizens

War on Terrorism Alan O'Day, 2017-09-08 President George W Bush maintained in his address of 20 September 2001 that the successful prosecution of the war against terrorism will require the judicious use of every resource at our command every means of diplomacy every tool of intelligence every instrument of law enforcement every financial influence and every necessary weapon of war Unlike the Cold War the War on Terrorism is neither a battle against some ideology nor bounded by physical boundaries or conventional political units such as nation states The War on Terrorism is the internationalisation or rather globalisation of previous wars Terror is not a nation and the enemies in such wars are not nations any regime such as Libya simply by repudiating terrorism can become an ally of the anti terror coalition Regimes that continue to practice terrorism against domestic opponents qualify to participate in the wider war if they conform to certain norms in external affairs The 28 articles reprinted here consider aspects of that most amorphous of animals the War on Terrorism They do not set out to provide all of the answers nor do they radiate a unified vision of what constitutes the war on terrorism the pieces begin from a range of political and intellectual outlooks Taken as a group however the difficulties of determining the limits and nature of the war on terrorism receive
