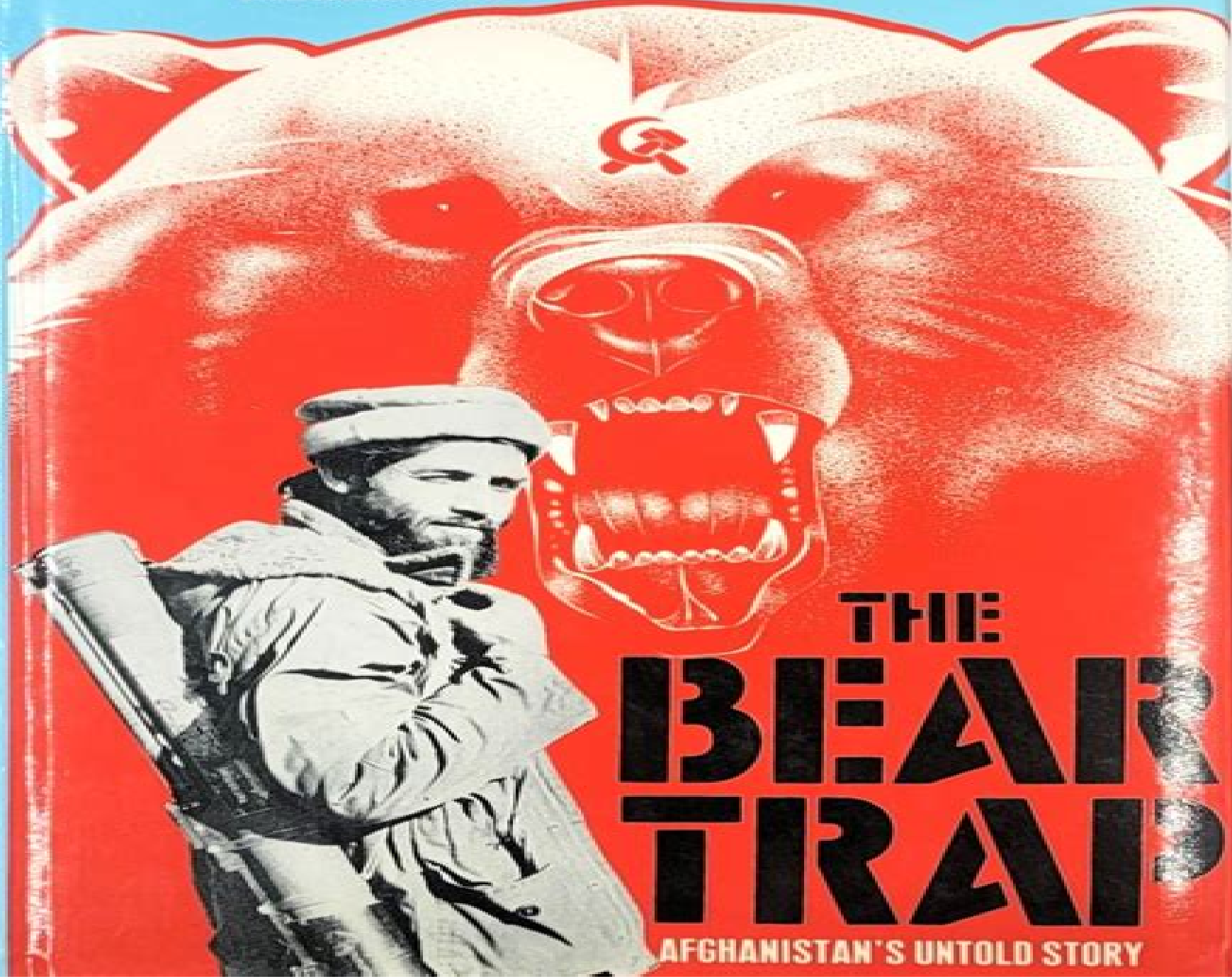

conditions proximity to the homeland and the presence of large numbers of bored young men Lischer instead focuses on the often ignored political context of the refugee crisis She suggests that three factors are crucial the level of the refugees political cohesion before exile the ability and willingness of the host state to prevent military activity and the contribution by aid agencies and outside parties of resources that exacerbate conflict Lischer s political explanation leads to policy prescriptions that are sure to be controversial using private security forces in refugee camps or closing certain camps altogether With no end in sight to the brutal wars that create refugee crises Dangerous Sanctuaries is vital reading for anyone concerned with how refugee flows affect the dynamics of conflicts around the world **CRISIS OF IMPUNITY The**

William Maley,1998-03 A useful analysis of the Taliban and politics and society in Afghanistan today Foreign Affairs Highly recommended Choice Composed of essays commissioned from the foremost experts on the Taliban this anthology traces the movement s origins its ascendance the reasons for its success and its role in the reconstruction of Afghanistan **My Life with the Taliban** Abdul Salam Zaeef,2010-01-01 This is the autobiography of Abdul Salam Zaeef a senior former member of the Taliban His memoirs translated from Pashto are more than just a personal account of his extraordinary life My Life with the Taliban offers a counter narrative to the standard accounts of Afghanistan since 1979 Zaeef describes growing up in rural poverty in Kandahar province Both of his parents died at an early age and the Russian invasion of 1979 forced him to flee to Pakistan He started fighting the jihad in 1983 during which time he was associated with many major figures in the anti Soviet resistance including the current Taliban head Mullah Mohammad Omar After the war Zaeef returned to a quiet life in a small village in Kandahar but chaos soon overwhelmed Afghanistan as factional fighting erupted after the Russians pulled out Disgusted by the lawlessness that ensued Zaeef was one among the former mujahidin who were closely involved in the discussions that led to the emergence of the Taliban in 1994 Zaeef then details his Taliban career as civil servant and minister who negotiated with foreign oil companies as well as with Afghanistan s own resistance leader Ahmed Shah Massoud Zaeef was ambassador to Pakistan at the time of the 9 11 attacks and his account discusses the strange phoney war period before the US led intervention toppled the Taliban In early 2002 Zaeef was handed over to American forces in Pakistan notwithstanding his diplomatic status and spent four and a half years in prison

including several years in Guantanamo before being released without having been tried or charged with any offence My Life with the Taliban offers a personal and privileged insight into the rural Pashtun village communities that are the Taliban's bedrock It helps to explain what drives men like Zaeef to take up arms against the foreigners who are foolish enough to invade his homeland Historical Dictionary of Afghanistan Thomas H. no Americans fought on the battlefield The CIA did not send officers into Afghanistan to fight or even to train In 1989 victory for the American side of the cold war seemed complete Now we can see that a new era was also beginning in the Afghan war in the 1980s the era of the global jihad This book examines the lessons we can learn from this intelligence operation for the future and makes some observations on what came next in Afghanistan and what is likely yet to come

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
