Geoffroy of Villehardouin, Marshal of Champagne Theodore Evergates, 2024-01-15 Geoffroy of Villehardouin Marshal of Champagne by Theodore Evergates traces the remarkable life of Geoffroy of Villehardouin c 1148 c 1217 from his earliest years in Champagne through his last years in Greece after the crusade The fourth son of a knight Geoffroy became marshal of Champagne principal negotiator in organizing the Fourth Crusade chief of staff of the expedition to and conquest of Constantinople garrison commander of Constantinople and in his late fifties field commander defending the Latin settlement in the Byzantine empire against invading Bulgarian armies and revolting Greek cities Known for his diplomatic skills and rectitude he served as the chief military advisor to Count Thibaut III of Champagne and later to Emperor Henry of Constantinople Geoffroy is remarkable as well for dictating the earliest war memoir in medieval Europe which is also the earliest prose narrative in Old French Addressed to a home audience in Champagne he described what he did what he saw and what he heard during his eight years on crusade and especially during the fraught period after the conquest of Constantinople His memoir *The Book of the Conquest of Constantinople* furnishes a commander s retrospective account of the main events and inner workings of the crusade the innumerable meetings and speeches the conduct not always commendable of the barons and the persistent discontent within the army as well as a celebration of his own deeds as a diplomat and a military commander

Aspar and the Struggle for the Eastern Roman Empire, AD 421-71 Ronald A. Bleeker, 2022-04-07 The first full length biography in English of Aspar the eastern Roman general and statesman this book explores his central role in the history and politics of the fragmenting Roman Empire in the fifth century It also considers what his life and career may suggest as to the differing fates of the eastern and western parts of the empire Taking a chronological approach Bleeker guides us through what is known of Aspar s life and his changing influence in the eastern Roman army and court Born and raised in Constantinople Aspar primarily viewed and presented himself as a Roman general

consul and senator Yet he also stood outside the Roman mainstream in two important ways as a member of the empire's barbarian military leadership and as a devout Arian Christian Early chapters treat his formative military experiences with the Persians a Roman usurper in Italy the Vandals in Africa and the Huns of Attila while later chapters focus on Aspar's political role in resolving the two imperial succession crises that struck the eastern Roman empire in the mid fifth century and his extended struggle to control the succession to Leo I Bleeker builds on earlier studies in three ways First previous work has largely concentrated on the role of barbarian generals in the western Roman empire while much less attention has been paid to similar figures such as Aspar in the east Secondly while important recent work has explored the prevalence of child emperors in the late fourth and early fifth centuries this book suggests a further evolution of the imperial role in the mid fifth century Finally while previous studies of this period have focused on Aspar's late career role in the succession struggles a full study allows us to see how and why his relations with other key figures within and outside the eastern Roman government changed over the course of his lengthy career
