



Adapted Physical Education and Therapeutic Recreation in Schools

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Adapted physical education is a mandated service, whereas therapeutic recreation and traditional recreation are considered related services under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act. In this article, the authors describe the distinctions between the services, recognition of need for referral, methods of assessment, sample Individualized Education Program goals with short-term objectives and/or benchmarks, strategies for the classroom teachers, and interventions and service delivery models typically used by physical education teachers and recreational therapists.

Physical education is mandated by the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA, 1997). Recreation is listed as one of the related services, along with occupational therapy (OT), physical therapy (PT), and speech and language pathology (SLP). Traditional physical education by definition is no different than adapted physical education, in which the primary focus is on offering an individualized developmentally appropriate education based on cognitive, motor, and personal-social development. Both adapted and traditional physical education place a major emphasis on gross-and fine-motor development and physical activity promotion, but adapted physical education merely tends to require more extensive changes (determined by the Individualized Education Program [IEP]) for individual appropriateness, ranging from a little extra help in the inclusive physical education class to separate setting, one-on-one instruction. Recreational therapists can motivate students to use motor skills learned in adapted physical education in community recreation activities, as well as collaborate with OT, PT, and SLP staff members in public school interdisciplinary service teams.

Physical Education

P.L. 94-142, Education for All Handicapped Children Act "identified physical education as a direct service required for students with disabilities" (Auxeter, Pyfer, & Huettig, 2001, p. 12). Several justifications for this requirement have been developed since the P.L. 94-142 mandate. Although physical education has long been valued as a key factor in the holistic education of children with special needs, it was not until recently that the specific benefits, capabilities, and goals of physical education were recognized.

For example, researchers are just recently beginning to fully understand the connections between movement or physical activity and important educational areas such as growth, development, learning, and behavior, as well as the disabilities or disorders that occur within each of these areas. Some examples of these recent findings include the following:
