The Arapahoes, Our People Virginia Cole Trenholm, 1986 The Arapahoes who simultaneously occupy the three major divisions of the Great Plains are typical but the least known of the Plains tribes Overshadowed by their more hostile allies the Sioux and Cheyennes they have been neglected by historians This book traces their history from prehistoric times in Minnesota and Canada to the turn of the century in Wyoming Montana and Oklahoma when their cultural history ended and adjustment to the white man s way began It covers their way of life dealings with traders treaties battles division into branches and reservation life There are detailed accounts of the Ghost Dance and peyote cult A study of the two branches Southern and Northern is a dramatic lesson in the effects of acculturation Forced to accept the white man s way the Southern people after losing their ceremonials and tribal lands in Oklahoma have gradually resigned themselves to the alien culture The Northern Arapahoes on the Wind River Reservation in Wyoming however still cling to their original traditions They tell their time honored tales pour out their souls in music and dance to their drums much as they did in pre reservation days although they dress in the manner of the white man and abide by his regulations Flat Pipe the sacred palladium said to have come to our people when the world began stays in their safe keeping and they honor it in occasional ceremony The Pipe is the unifying symbol of the two branches of the tribe

The Discovery of the Oregon Trail Robert Stuart, 1995-01-01 Robert Stuart saw the American West a few years after Meriwether Lewis and William Clark and like them kept a journal of his epic experience A partner in John Jacob Astor s Pacific Fur Company the Scotsman shipped for Oregon aboard the Tonquin in 1810 and helped found the ill fated settlement of Astoria at the mouth of the Columbia River In 1812 facing disaster Stuart and six others slipped away from Astoria and headed east His journal edited and annotated by Philip Ashton Rollins describes their hazardous 3 700 mile journey to St Louis Crossing the Rockies in winter they faced death by cold starvation and hostile Indians But they made history by discovering what came to be called the Oregon Trail including South Pass over which thousands of emigrants would travel west in mid century Besides Stuart s narrative this volume contains important material about Astoria and the fate of the Tonquin as well as the harrowing account of Wilson Price Hunt who headed a party of overlanders traveling east to join the Astorians

Voices in the Drum R. David Edmunds, 2023-10-24 The history of indigenous peoples in North America is long and complex Many scholarly accounts now rely on statistical data to reconstruct this past but amid all the facts and figures it is easy to lose sight of the human side of the story How did Native people express their thoughts and feelings and what sources of strength did they rely on to persevere through centuries of change In this engaging narrative acclaimed historian R David Edmunds combines careful research with creative storytelling to give voice to indigenous individuals and families

and to illustrate the impact of pivotal events on their lives A nonfiction account accompanies each narrative to provide necessary historical and cultural context Voices in the Drum features nine stories each of which focuses on a fictional character who is a composite or representation of historical people This series of portrayals takes the reader on an epic journey through time beginning in the early 1400s with the Mound Builder cultures and ending with the modern day urbanization of Native people Along the way we observe fictional characters interacting with real historical figures such as Anthony Wayne Tecumseh and John Sutter and taking part in actual events such as the Battle of Fallen Timbers the Trail of Tears the California gold rush and the forced removal of Native children to off reservation boarding schools The people portrayed in these pages belong to various tribes including Potawatomis Lakotas Oneidas and Cherokees Their individual stories ranging from humorous to tragic give readers a palpable sense of how tribal peoples reacted to the disruptive changes forced on them by European colonizers and U S government policies Both entertaining and insightful the stories in this volume traverse a range of time periods events themes and genres As such they reverberate like voices in the drum inviting readers of all backgrounds to engage anew with the rich history and cultures of indigenous peoples *Arapahoe Politics, 1851-1978* Loretta Fowler, 1986-01-01 The Northern Arapahoes of the Wind River Reservation contradict many of the generalizations made about political change among native plains people Loretta Fowler explores how in response to the realities of domination by Americans the Arapahoes have avoided serious factional divisions and have succeeded in legitimizing new authority through the creation and use of effective political symbols

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
