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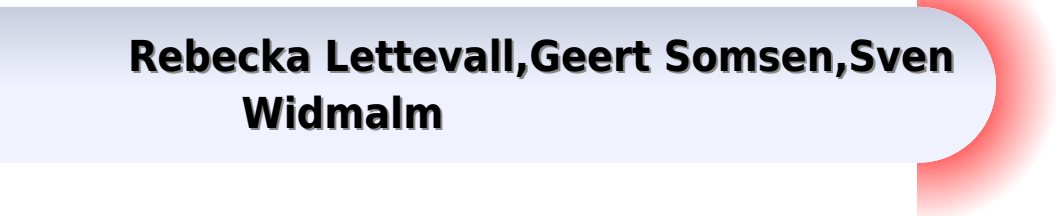

powerfully articulates the centrality of propaganda and the mass media to interwar European cultural diplomacy and politics and the tense combative atmosphere of European international relations from the beginning of the First World War well past the end of the Second *Britain and Interwar Danubian Europe* Dragan Bakic, 2017-05-04 Danubian Europe presented constant and serious security risks for European peace and stability and for that reason contrary to conventional wisdom it commanded the attention of British diplomacy with a view to appeasing local conflicts Britain and Interwar Danubian Europe examines the manner in which the Foreign Office perceived and treated the antagonism between the Little Entente comprised of Czechoslovakia Yugoslavia and Romania and Hungary on the one hand and revisionist Bulgaria and her neighbours in the Balkans on the other and the impact that these local conflicts had in connection with Franco Italian rivalry in Central South Eastern Europe With Hitler's accession to power Danubian Europe was viewed in Whitehall in relation to its place in the prospective policy for preserving Austrian independence and containing German aggression Dragan Bakic argues that the British approach to security problems in Danubian Europe had certain permanent features which stemmed from the general British outlook on the new successor states the members of the Little Entente founded on the ruins of the Habsburg monarchy This book shows that it was the lack of confidence in their stability and permanence as well as the misperceptions about the motives and intentions of the policies pursued by other Powers towards Central South Eastern Europe which accounted for the apparent sluggishness and ineffectiveness of the Foreign Office's dealings with security challenges Based on extensive original archival research this is a fascinating volume for any historian keen to know more about the 20th century history of East Central Europe or British foreign policy in the interwar years *Re-contextualising East Central European History* Robert Pyrah, 2017-12-02 Twenty years after the fall of Communism scholarship on East Central Europe has adopted mainstream western methodologies but remains preoccupied with a narrow range of themes Nationalism identity fin de siècle art and culture and revisionist historiography dominate the field to the detriment of other subjects Using a variety of lenses literary political linguistic medical the authors address a conspectus of original themes

Business, Race, and Politics in British India, c.1850-1960 Maria Misra,1999-04-29 This is a study of the political and economic activities of an important group of British businessmen in India between 1850 and 1960 Though denounced by Indian nationalists as the economic arm of the British Raj the firms of these Managing Agents seemed unassailable before the First World War However during the inter war period they rapidly lost their commanding position to both Indian and other foreign competitors Dr Misra argues that the failure of these firms was in part the consequence of their particular and ultimately self defeating attitudes towards business politics and race She casts new light on British colonial society in India and makes an important contribution to current debates on the nature of the British Empire and the causes of Britain s relative economic decline
