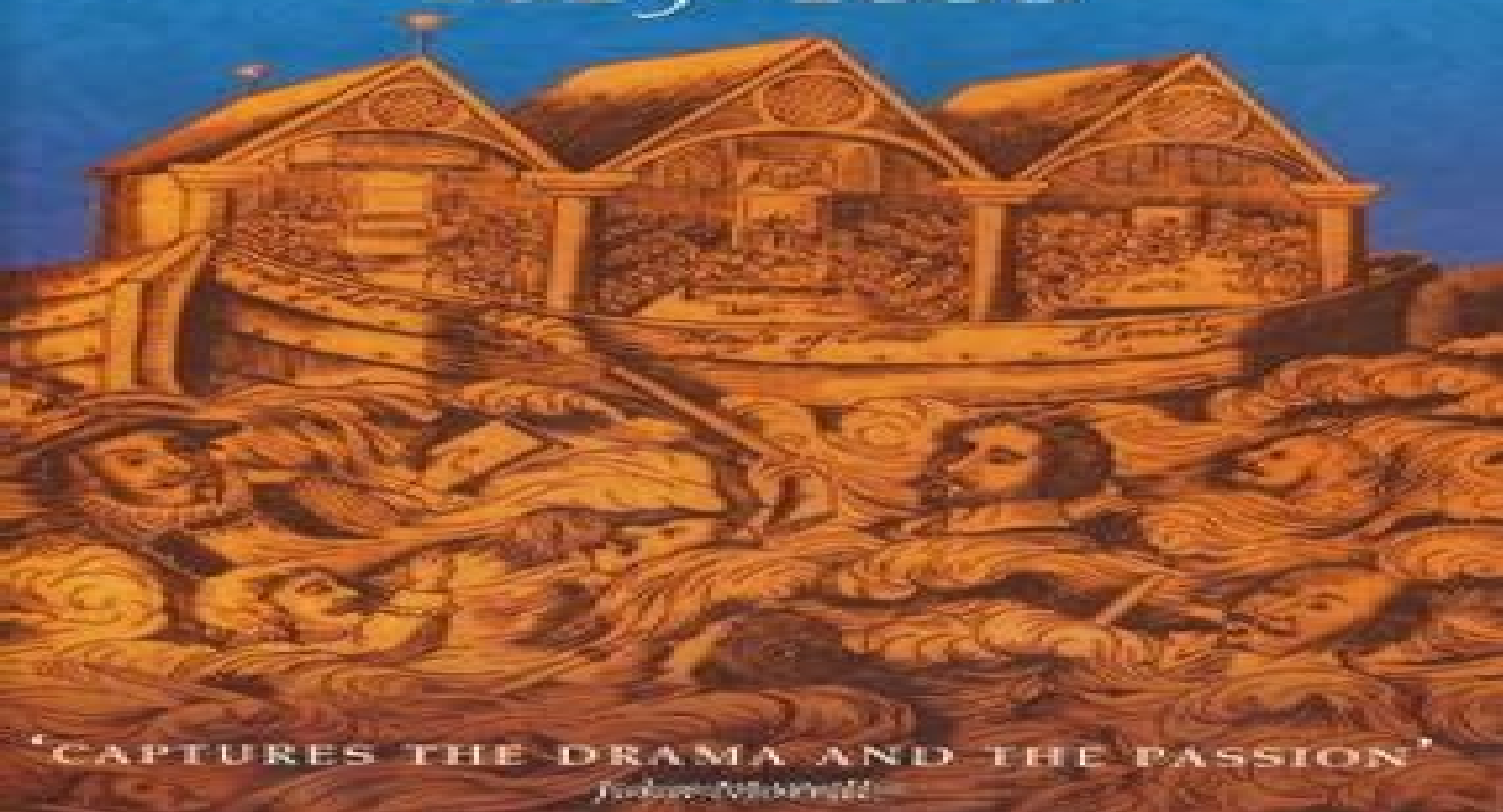

Oliver Cromwell (Penguin Monarchs)

David Horspool,2017-02-23 Although he styled himself His Highness adopted the court ritual of his royal predecessors and lived in the former royal palaces of Whitehall and Hampton Court Oliver Cromwell was not a king in spite of the best efforts of his supporters to crown him Yet as David Horspool shows in this illuminating new portrait of England s Lord Protector Cromwell the Puritan son of Cambridgeshire gentry wielded such influence that it would be a pretence to say that power really lay with the collective The years of Cromwell s rise to power shaped by a decade long civil war saw a sustained attempt at the collective government of England the first attempts at a real Union of Britain the beginnings of empire a radically new solution to the idea of a national religion atrocities in Ireland and the readmission to England of the Jews a people officially banned for over three and a half centuries At the end of it Oliver Cromwell had emerged as the country s sole ruler to his enemies and probably to most of his countrymen his legacy looked as likely to last as that of the Stuart dynasty he had replaced

Rebellion Tim Harris,2014-01-09 A gripping new account of one of the most important and exciting periods of British and Irish history the reign of the first two Stuart kings from 1567 to the outbreak of civil war in 1642 and why ultimately all three of their kingdoms were to rise in rebellion against Stuart rule Both James VI and I and his son Charles I were reforming monarchs who endeavoured to bolster the authority of the crown and bring the churches in their separate kingdoms into closer harmony with one another Many of James s initiatives proved controversial his promotion of the plantation of Ulster his reintroduction of bishops and ceremonies into the Scottish kirk and his stormy relationship with his English parliaments over religion and finance but he just about got by Charles despite continuing many of his father s policies in church and state soon ran into difficulties and provoked all three of his kingdoms to rise in rebellion first Scotland in 1638 then Ireland in 1641 and finally England in 1642 Was Charles s failure then a personal one was he simply not up to the job Or was the multiple kingdom inheritance fundamentally unmanageable so that it was only a matter of time before things fell apart Did perhaps the way that James sought to address his problems have the effect of making things more difficult for his son Tim Harris addresses all these questions and more in this wide ranging and deeply researched new account dealing with high politics and low constitutional and religious conflict propaganda and public opinion across the three kingdoms while also paying due attention to the broader European and Atlantic contexts

Thomas Violet, a Sly and Dangerous Fellow Amos Tubb,2017-10-06 Thomas Violet a Sly and Dangerous Fellow chronicles the life and adventures of Thomas Violet an Englishman who lived from 1609 to 1662 During the course of his tumultuous life Violet was a goldsmith a spy a prisoner of war during the English Civil War a traitor to both sides a major economic theorist an anti Semite who nearly drove the Jews of England out of the country and a suicide Violet s

life consisted of one unbelievable escapade after another He was a scoundrel who used his knowledge of the financial markets of his day to legally extort money out of people in scheme after scheme for nearly thirty years Along the way he was caught up in the English Civil War and interacted with many of the major players he knew and worked for King Charles I Oliver Cromwell and King Charles II In desperate times both King Charles I and Oliver Cromwell were willing to use the unsavory Violet to help solve the financial crisis both men faced as rulers of England Violet s knowledge of the silver trade in particular would bring untold riches to Oliver Cromwell However Charles II had no need of Violet and when Violet could not convince Charles II to extort money from England s Jews Violet committed suicide rather than face the world without a royal patron Readers will be fascinated and outraged by Violet s actions

Thomas Fuller William Brown Patterson,2018 Long considered a highly distinctive English writer Thomas Fuller 1608 1661 has not been treated as the significant historian he was Fuller s The Church History of Britain 1655 was the first comprehensive history of Christianity from antiquity to the upheavals of the Protestant and Catholic Reformations and the tumultuous events of the English civil wars His numerous publications outside the genre of history sermons meditations pamphlets on current thought and events reflected and helped to shape public opinion during the revolutionary era in which he lived Thomas Fuller Discovering England s Religious Past highlights the fact that Fuller was a major contributor to the flowering of historical writing in early modern England W B Patterson provides both a biography of Thomas Fuller s life and career in the midst of the most wrenching changes his country had ever experienced and a critical account of the origins growth and achievements of a new kind of history in England a process to which he made a significant and original contribution The volume begins with a substantial introduction dealing with memory uses of the past and the new history of England in the late sixteenth and early seventeenth centuries Fuller was moved by the changes in Church and state that came during the civil wars that led to the trial and execution of King Charles I and to the Interregnum that followed He sought to revive the memory of the English past recalling the successes and failures of both distant and recent events The book illuminates Fuller s focus on history as a means of understanding the present as well as the past and on religion and its important place in English culture and society

Oliver Cromwell Graham Goodlad,1979-01-01 **Colonial Massachusetts Laws and Liberties and the English Commonwealth** Charles Edward Smith,2024-08-19 On July 4 1653 the Nominate or Barebones Parliament convened with a minority of committed radicals Levellers and religious extremists and a conservative majority of Cromwell s allies During acrimonious debates on law reform the radicals demanded a condensed law book similar to the one adopted in Colonial Massachusetts These mostly overlooked events reveal a radical wing of Puritanism determined to found a self governing state fully cognizant of the real possibility that England would interdict such attempts by force of arms This work investigates the motives for such a hazardous undertaking and the possible influences these events had on the colony s posterity
