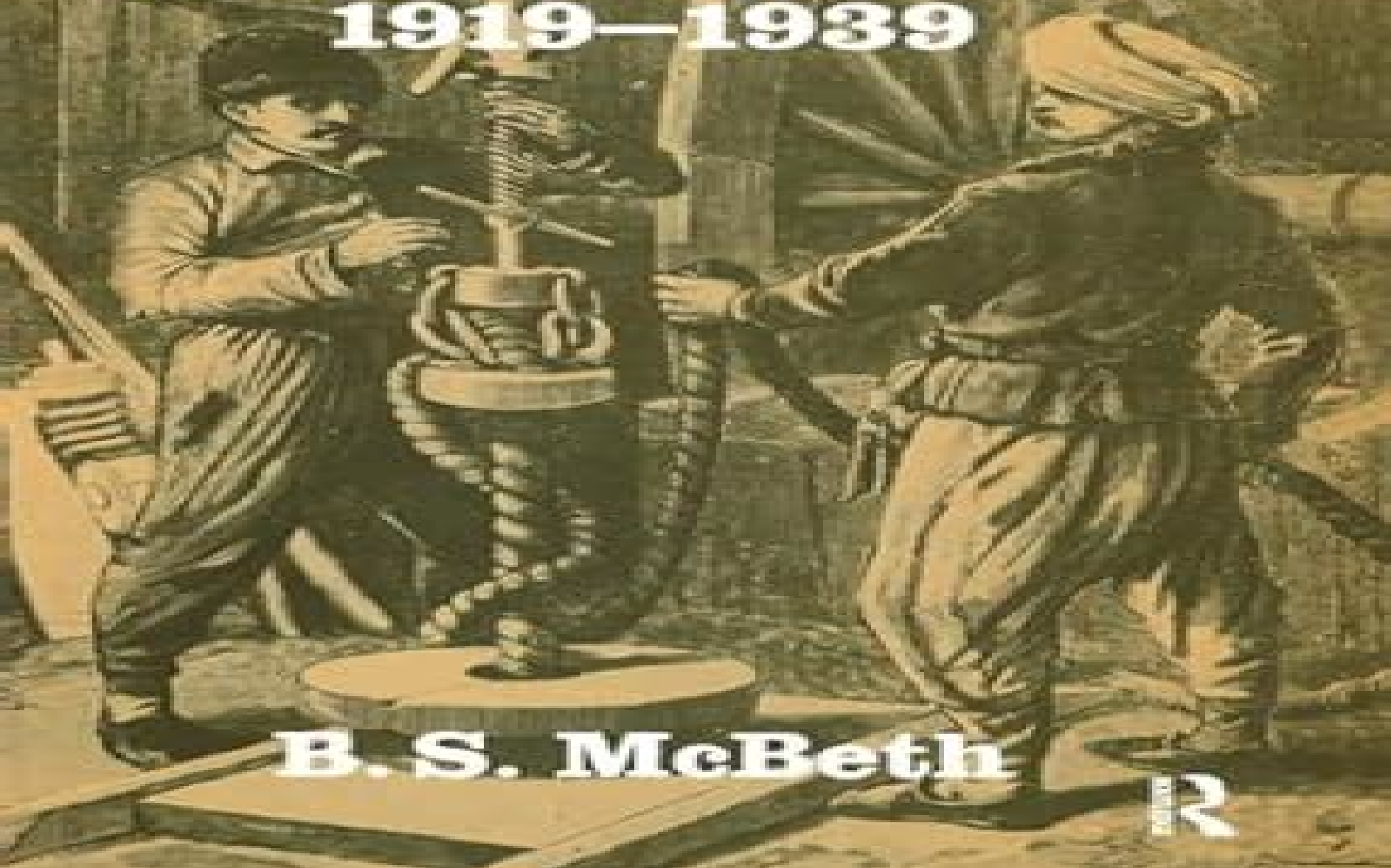

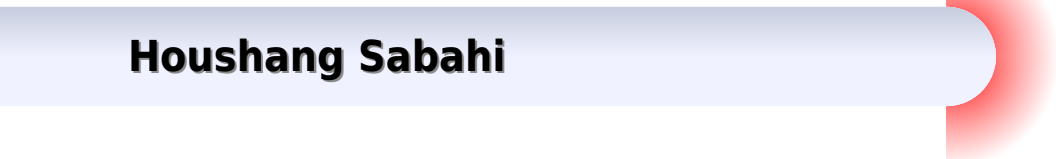

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British Policy in Persia, 1918-1925 Houshang Sabahi,2005-06-28 First Published in 1990 Viewed from the perspective of Whitehall Persia was a crossroads where Britain s European and Indian interests met Control of Persia by any European power was bound to jeopardize the security of British India At first London and India hesitantly experimented with the policy of bringing Persia into the British sphere of influence either by contracting an alliance with her or by turning her into a protectorate Persia s crushing defeat in the war with Russia put an end to these experiments The Turkomanchai Treaty of 1828 firmly established Russian influence at Tehran For the rest of the nineteenth century the basic thrust of British policy was to prevent Russia from taking control of Persia and at the same time to avoid a serious dispute with her over Persia So Persia had to be preserved as a buffer state This volume charts the history of Persian Policies from 1918 to 1925 The History of the British Petroleum Company Ronald W. Emergence of the British Oil Industry Geoffrey Jones,1981-06-18 **The Oil Business and the State** Øystein Noreng,2021-10-18 National oil companies are big business with about 80 percent of the world s proven oil reserves and they are crucial to the world s energy supplies They are giants some of the world s largest companies measured by market capitalisation cash flow and investment Little is known about their modus operandi how they make decisions about investment and production or about relations with their government owners However it is known that they conduct business with a political mandate often with multiple long term objectives broadly defined and hard to quantify Unclear mandates give national oil companies leeway to pursue their own distinctive interests apart from those of the government owner As investors governments are less zealous than private investors They generally observe multiple objectives not only return on capital Therefore the senior management of national oil companies enjoy more discretionary power and consider longer time horizons than their counterparts in the private sector The Oil Business and the State explains the practice of state ownership in a capital intensive industry with high risks and high return and how these companies act in a market with imperfect competition This book looks to give readers more insight into the oil industry into the background of oil exporting countries as well as the economic and political challenges confronting them including problems of state ownership The book discusses

wider consequences of China replacing the United States as the world's leading oil importer. It will be of interest to researchers, academics, and students in the fields of international business, management history, corporate governance, political economy, and economic development of oil-rich countries.

The History of Petroleum Exploration on Barbados, 1865-1985 Sylvan Spooner, 2024-10-28. This book documents the history of the Barbadian petroleum industry and the effort of that island's black nationalist political elite to take control of the island's petroleum resources. In a direct challenge to the white Barbadian planter class, this group made it known that it wished to wrest from them ownership of the colony's petroleum rights. Stating that it would do so for the national good rather than for the good of the few who for centuries held power within the colony, the island's political leadership gave notice of its desire to disrupt the colonial order. The politically charged appropriation of this natural resource, which one member of the House of Lords called an unhealthy manifestation of self-expression, was a brazen and defiant stand against colonialism and imperialism, filled with political risk for the island. This book documents petroleum exploration on Barbados from the mid-nineteenth century to 1985 and examines the island's careful cultivation of political and foreign policy relationships as well as the machinations involved as the island strove to take control of its petroleum industry.

By doing so, Mueller reveals how the revival of Iranian national ambitions in the Gulf had a significant effect on the dense web of Arab-Iranian relations during the interwar period. Shedding new light on our current understanding of the present-day Arab-Iranian conflict, this study, which pays particular attention to Bahrain and the Trucial States, United Arab Emirates, fills a significant gap in the literature on the history of Arab-Iranian relations in the Gulf and Iran's Persian Gulf policy during the Reza Shah period.

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
