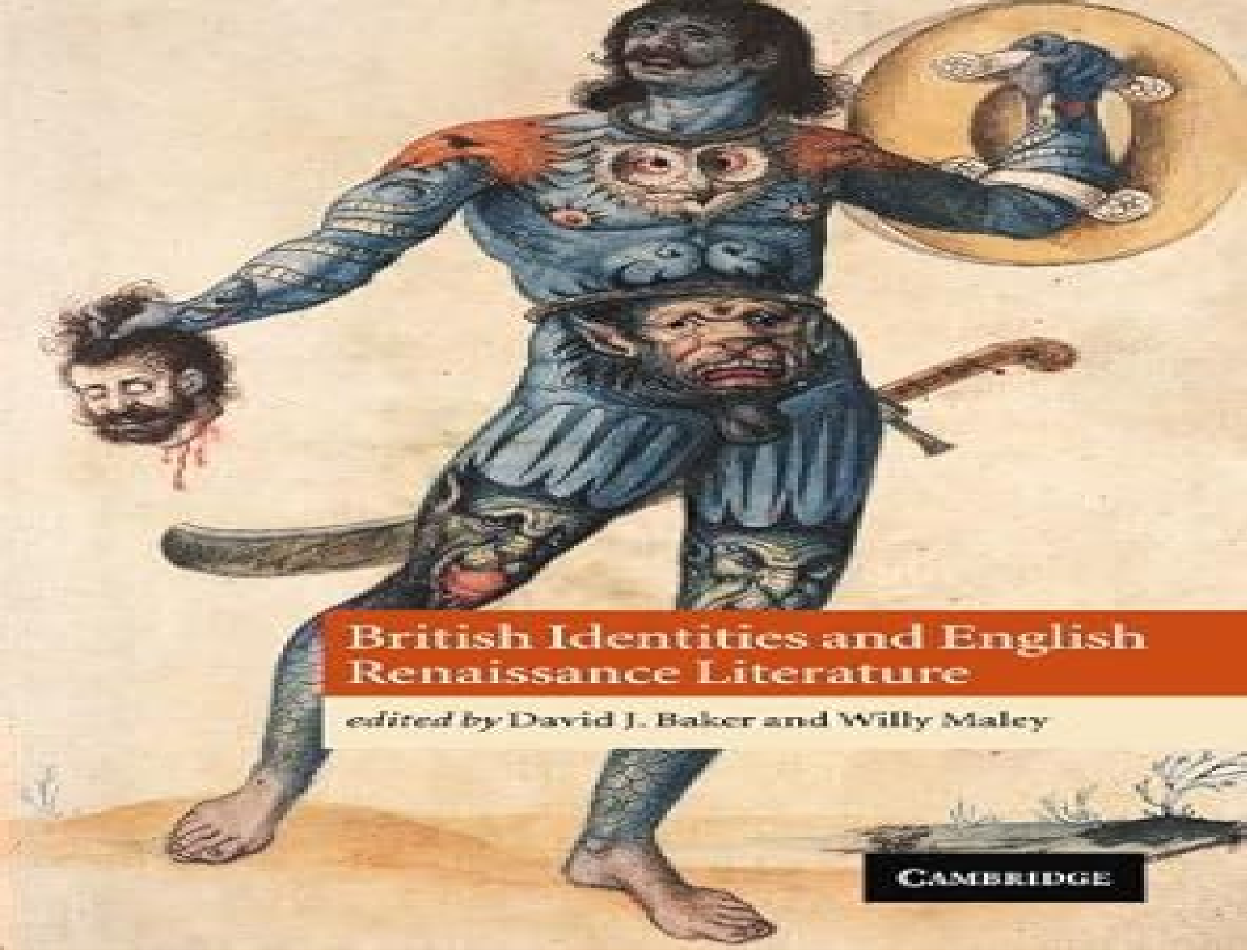

Baker, Willy Maley, 2002-05-16 Though British history and identity in the early modern period are intensively researched areas the role of literature in the construction of Britishness is under examined English history of the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries often overlooks the contribution of Ireland Scotland and Wales to the formation of the British state Historians describe Britain as a multiple kingdom with a long history of conflict In this 2002 volume a team of leading Renaissance literary critics read a broad range of texts from the period including plays of Shakespeare in light of British history Prominent historians respond to the issues raised by the volume This collection opened up a different kind of literary history and has pressing relevance for discussions of Britishness

Royalists and Cosmopolitans considers how the marginalized perspective of 16th century English Catholic exiles and 17th century English royalist exiles helped to generate a form of cosmopolitanism that was rooted in contemporary religious and national identities but also transcended those identities Author Brian C Lockett argues that English discourses of nationhood were in conversation with two opposing cosmopolitan perspectives one that sought to cultivate and sustain the emerging English nationalism and imperialism and another that challenged English nationhood from the perspective of those Englishmen who viewed the kingdom as one province within the larger transnational Christian commonwealth Lockett illustrates how the latter cosmopolitan perspective produced within two communities of exiled English subjects separated in time by half a century influenced fiction writers such as Sir Philip Sidney Edmund Spenser Anthony Munday Sir John Harington John Milton and Aphra Behn Ultimately he shows that early modern cosmopolitans critiqued the emerging discourse of English nationhood from a traditional religious and political perspective even as their writings eventually gave rise to later secular Enlightenment forms of cosmopolitanism

Boudica's Odyssey in Early Modern England Samantha Frénée-Hutchins, 2016-04-15 This diachronic study of Boudica serves as a sourcebook of references to Boudica in the early modern period and gives an overview of the ways in which her story was processed and exploited by the different players of the times who wanted to give credence and support to their own belief systems The author examines the different apparatus of state ideology which processed the social religious and political representations of Boudica for public absorption and helped form the popular myth we have of Boudica today By exploring images of the Briton warrior queen across two reigns which witnessed an act of political union and a move from English female rule under Elizabeth I to British Scottish masculine rule under James VI I the author conducts a critical cartography of the ways in which gender colonialism and nationalism crystallised around this crucial historical figure Concentrating on the original transmission and reception of the ancient texts the author analyses the historical works of Hector Boece Raphael Holinshed and William Camden as well as the canonical literary figures of Edmund Spenser William Shakespeare and John Fletcher She also looks at aspects of other primary sources not covered in previous scholarship such as Humphrey Llwyd's Breuiary of Britayne 1573 Petruccio Ubaldini's Le Vite delle donne illustri del regno d Inghilterra e del regno di Scotia 1588 and Edmund Bolton's Nero Caesar 1624 Furthermore she incorporates archaeological research relating to Boudica

Early Modern Constructions of Europe Florian Kläger, Gerd Bayer, 2016-02-12 Between the medieval conception of Christendom and the political visions of modernity ideas of Europe underwent a transformative and catalytic period that saw a cultural process of renewed self definition or self Europeanization The contributors to this volume address this process analyzing how Europe was imagined between 1450 and 1750 By whom in which contexts and for what purposes was Europe made into a subject of discourse Which forms did early modern Europe take and what functions did they serve Essays examine the role of factors such as religion history space and geography ethnicity and alterity patronage and dynasty migration and education language
